If elected, Clinton promises to...

Education

- Launch a national campaign to elevate and modernize the teaching profession.
- Encourage states to use federal education funding to implement social and emotional support interventions in lieu of overly punitive discipline dismantling the school-to-prison pipeline.
- Make in-state four-year public colleges and universities tuition-free for families with income under 125,000 and will make all community colleges tuition free.

Immigration

- Introduce a comprehensive immigration reform that will host a pathway to full and equal citizenship within her first 100 days in office.
- Expand fee waivers to alleviate naturalization costs.
- Increase outreach and education to help more people navigate the process.

Health Care

- Defend and expand the Affordable Care Act and build on its success to bring the promise of affordable health care to more people and make a "public option" possible.
- Work to bring down out-of-pocket cost like copays and deductibles.
- Demand lower drug costs for hardworking families and seniors, and work toward reducing the cost of prescription drugs.

If elected, Trump promises to...

Education

- Immediately add additional federal investments toward school choice.
- Work with Congress on reforms to ensure universities are making a good faith effort to reduce the cost of college and student debt.
- Ensure higher education will be easier to access, pay for and finish including vocational and technical education

Immigration

- Curb uncontrolled foreign worker admissions, which will protect lawful immigrants.
- Establish new immigration controls to boost wages.
- Establish a way to vet applicants ensuring they support America's values, institutions and people.
- Enforce the existing immigration laws of the United States

Health Care

- Repeal and replace Obamacare with Health Savings Accounts (HSAs).
- Create a patient-centered health care system that promotes choice, quality and affordability.
- Establish a state program to ensure access to coverage for individuals who have not maintained continuous coverage.
- Create a dynamic market by allowing people to purchase insurance across state lines in all 50 states.
